**Textiles Project Group: Annual Report 2012** 

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The Textiles Group held one meeting in 2012 focussed on providing support for OECD in their efforts

to harmonise methods for Tier 1 testing of treated articles (demonstrating external effects). Two

international ring tests have been completed. The data has been employed in the drafting of an OECD

Test Guideline. In addition, a protocol was designed to examine the impact of treated textiles on the

rate of decline of populations reaching them through splashes of contaminated liquids (Tier 2). It will

examine the impact of suspension medium on the activity of two treatment systems (organic and

inorganic) against two test species. Materials suitable for the study have been distributed and the study

started in Q4 2012. Methods that can be used to model the control of odour are also being sought

particularly to model foot, urine and body odour.
